Turner Construction Company Awarded Fort Irwin Replacement Hospital

Washington, D.C., June 22, 2012– The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District selected Turner Construction Company to build the Fort Irwin Replacement Hospital in San Bernardino, California.
