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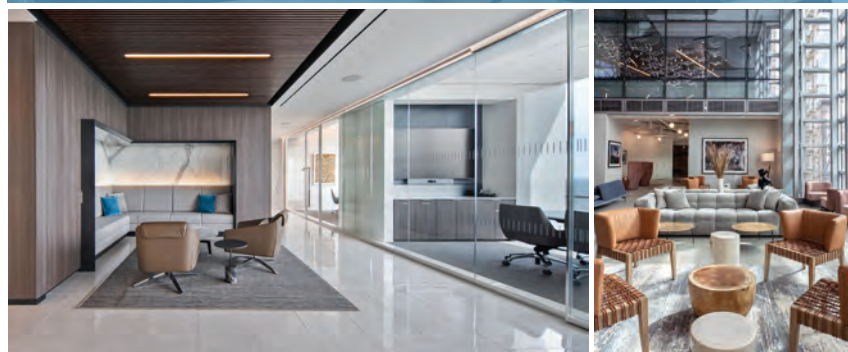


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Industry Report

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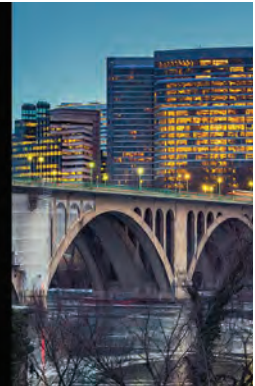
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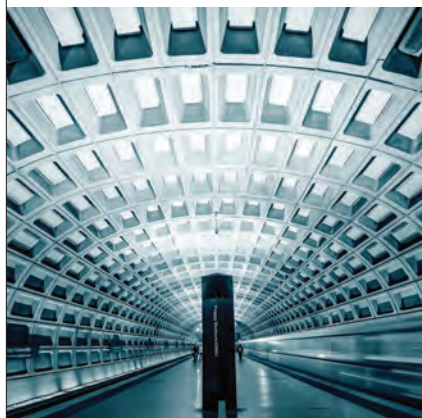

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2022 Annual WBC Craftsmanship Awards

The National Capital Region building industry came together on June 3rd to personally recognize the area's outstanding craftsmen during the 66th annual WBC Craftsmanship Awards banquet. More than 14,000 men and women have been individually honored over the past 66 years for their work on 3,500+ Craftsmanship Award winning entries.

To kick off the evening, two new WBC Craftsman Hall of Fame inductees were honored. Each year up to five craftsmen may be nominated by the Craftsmanship Awards Committee to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. Established in 2008, the Hall of Fame currently has 46 exceptional members.

This year 198 nominations were received in ten trade categories from sitework to finishes. Each entry was evaluated in March by a team made up of individuals with a wide range of industry experience. The judges represented a broad cross section of the construction industry including architects, interior designers, general contractors, subcontractors, construction consultants, and engineers. All evaluations were compiled, results tallied, and 62 winning entries were identified based upon the judges' scoring.

"We would like to acknowledge and thank all of you who participated as judges this year. Your support is a vital component to the success of this event," said Lynn Maia, ZBeta Consulting, 2022 Craftsmanship Awards Committee Chair.
